- **Special Events: Musical Programs & Concerts. Art Demonstrations & Lectures – 34 years**
Musicians, Vocalists, & Visual Artists have given presentations and discussions of their careers, & work.
- **FYI Opera Series – 27 years**
In cooperation with Cleveland Institute of Music, Artistic Director David Bamberger presents CIM's upcoming season of operas with students performing arias from their opera performances.
- **Westlake Porter Public Library children's programs and books – 25 years**
